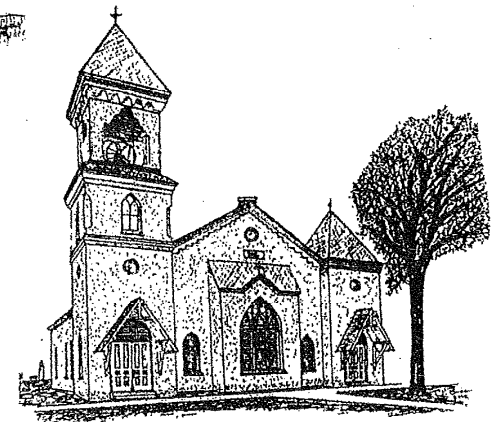
Our **Annual Barnstormers Outing** is this **Wednesday, July 24!**
