Today's opening hymn "This Is My Father's World" was written by Maltbie D. Babcock, born 1858 in Syracuse, New York. Following graduation from Auburn Theological Seminary, he became a Presbyterian minister and served the Brown Memorial Presbyterian Church in Baltimore, Maryland, later serving a congregation in New York City. While in Baltimore he was especially popular with students from Johns Hopkins University, but he ministered to people from all walks of life. In addition to hymn texts and devotionals, he wrote poetry along with published sermons. The familiar tune is an adapted English Folk melody.
